OBJECTIVE

Re: Municipal Enforcement Policy

AND THATL the appropriate By-Law be passed to implement this policy.

BACKGROUND

Staff attended the virtual Municipal Licensing & Law Enforcement forum on December 1, 2022; the forum identified the purpose of developing a Municipal Enforcement Policy.

The Municipal Enforcement policy allows for a transparent, consistent, fair, unbiased and effective process towards enforcement and prosecution of relevant laws.

Staff undertook the time to research other municipalities with Municipal Enforcement policies and have developed a Municipal Enforcement Policy that meets the needs of the Officers and the Community. The policy has been reviewed by the Municipal Enforcement Officers and the Department to ensure that there is clear expectations and processes towards the Municipal By-Laws and enforcement.

ANALYSIS

The purpose of the policy allows staff, Council and citizens to understand the procedure of governing and the handling of municipal by-law complaints by the Municipality and to ensure standardized, thorough, prompt and courteous receipt, processing, investigation, and resolution. This policy is intended to apply to both municipal by-laws and provincial statues which is the Municipality is responsible for enforcing.
