Should revisions to drawings, schedules, specifications or other documents be required when such revisions are inconsistent with approvals or instructions previously given by the client, or representatives, or are due to other causes not solely within the control of Brook McIlroy Inc., the client will be charged based on a fee basis to be agreed to with the client. A "Do Not Exceed" value shall be agreed upon prior to undertaking any additional work.

This agreement may be terminated by either party, upon not less than 30 days prior written notification to the other party. Brook McIlroy Inc. will be remunerated for all work completed and in progress up until the time of termination.
