ON THE WATER





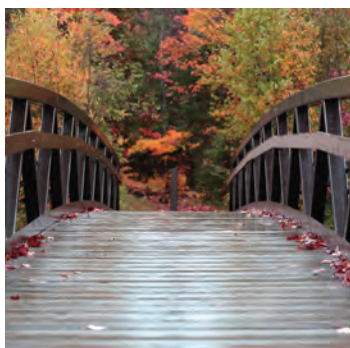
Elliot Lake is a **WATERSPORTS PARADISE.**

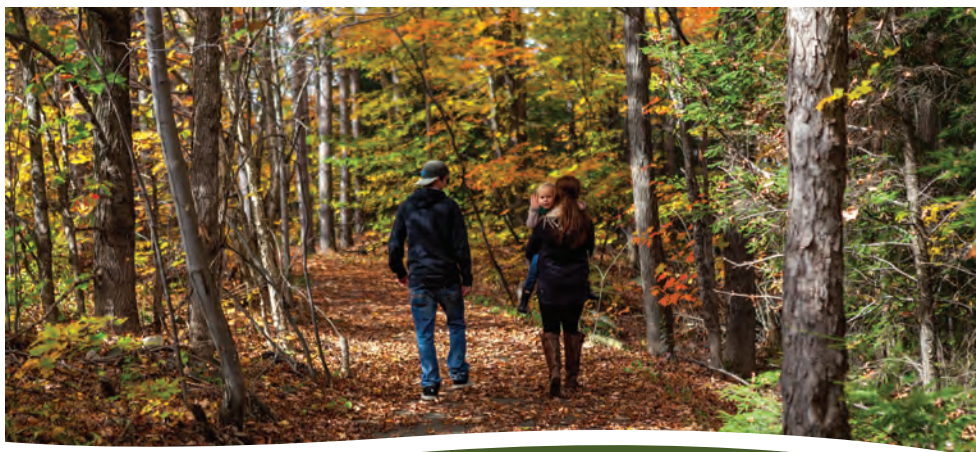
ON FOOT

No matter the season, Elliot Lake offers opportunities for those on two wheels. Bring your bike out on some of our **multi-use trails**, summer or winter.

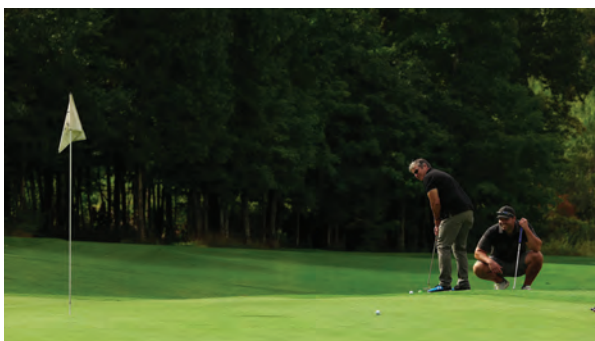
