## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ELLIOT LAKE

## **B**<sub>Y-LAW NO. 21-69</sub>

Being a By-Law to execution of the Transfer Payment Agreement for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP): Public Transit Stream and to repeal By-Law 21-18

**WHEREAS** it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of an Agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario for funding under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP): Public Transit Stream.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Elliot Lake hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Elliot Lake the Transfer Payment Agreement for the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program (ICIP): Public Transit Stream ("Agreement") between Her Majesty the Queen in right of the Province of Ontario, represented by the Minister of Transportation for the Province of Ontario, and the City of Elliot Lake in a form satisfactory to Legal Services.
- 2. THAT the Mayor and and City Clerk, as applicable, the delegate specified in Schedule "B" of the Agreement are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Elliot Lake any amendment to the Agreement or ancillary document necessary to fulfil the ICIP requirements in a form satisfactory to Legal Services.
- **3. THAT** the Mayor and City Clerk have the delegation of authority to execute any and all required documentation, on behalf of the City of Elliot Lake, as required under the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program.
- **4. THAT** the City of Elliot Lake commits to spending Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program funding in accordance with all of the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement.
- **THAT** the City of Elliot Lake commits to spending Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program funding only on implementing the approved projects identified in the Agreement.
