# REPORT OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER FOR THE CONSIDERATION OF COUNCIL

## **OBJECTIVE**

To provide Council with a recommendation to appoint a representative to the Mississagi Park Commission founding Board of Directors.

**AND THAT** Council appoint Mr. Daniel Gagnon as city representative on the Mississagi Park Commission founding board.

#### **BACKGROUND**

In November 2018, Council appointed Ashten Vlahovich and Ed Pearce to represent the city on the Mississagi Park Commission founding board of directors.

Council will recall that the Park Commission is intended to jointly manage the park via a new corporate entity made up of the City of Elliot Lake, Serpent River and Missisauga First Nations. The Commission has been established and is looking to have an inaugural meeting in the near future.

#### ANALYSIS

Council can appoint anyone it wishes, but the underlying rationale appeared to be one member of Council and one staff person. Recent changes in the staff complement in the economic development means a vacancy has been created on the board that should be filled as soon as possible.
